

School Board

Board Member Term of Office

The term of office for a School Board member begins immediately after both of the following occur:

1. The election authority canvasses the votes and declares the winner(s); this occurs within 21 days after the consolidated election held in April in the odd-numbered years.
2. The success candidate takes the oath of office as provided in Board policy 2:80 Board Member Oath and Conduct.

The term ends 4 years later when the successor assumes office.
